- As noted, Social Science 102 will be waived upon successful completion of LCCC Computer Information System Elective.
- As noted, recommend Speech 125 to satisfy King's Core 115 requirement.
- As noted, courses recommended to be taken at King's to satisfy LCCC requirements include Core 120 for mathematics elective requirement, Core 188 for POS 101, American Government, and to select from Core 271-279 for Science elective.
