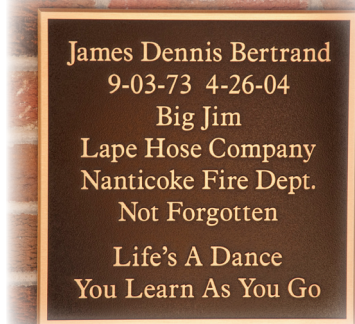
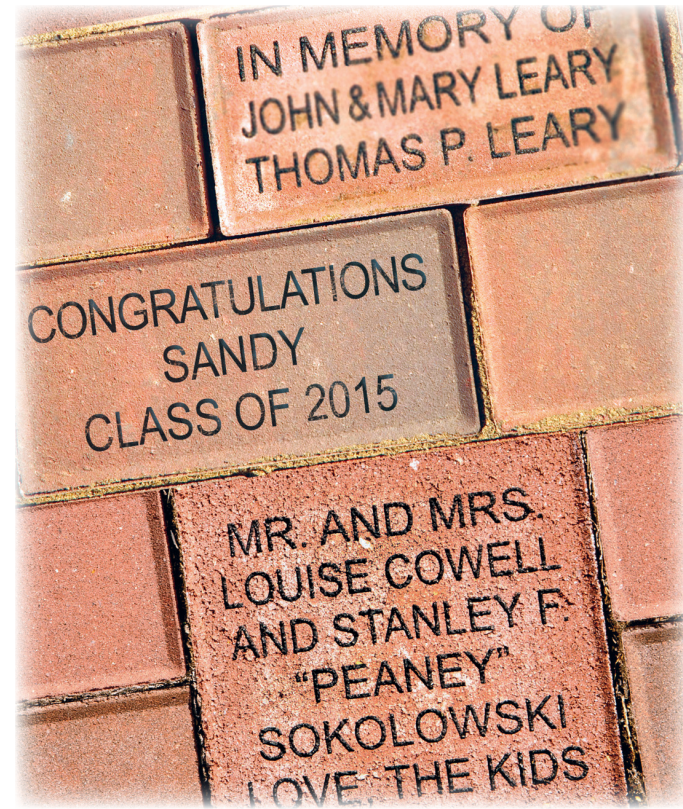

HONORING A FALLEN HERO

WHEN Michael Scott Carlo, a NYFD firefighter, lost his life in the World Trade Center on September 11, 2001, his mother wanted to honor him in a big way. In 2010, the Walk of Honor was established at LCCC, with the help of Michael's mother, the late Mrs. Phyllis Carlo. A year later, an original artifact from the World Trade Center was dedicated and added to the site.

LOCATED on the site of the Regional Public Safety Training Center across from the school's Prospect Street entrance, the Walk of Honor provides the opportunity to immortalize the memory of a loved one, commemorate a favorite LCCC faculty member, or yourself and grad year.

SPONSORSHIP OPTIONS

Bricks

Bricks can be purchased in two sizes: 4" x 8" or 6" x 12". The engraving on these bricks can be up to 14 characters per line, *including* spaces and punctuation. 3 lines are possible on the 4" x 8" brick, while 4 lines are possible on the 6" x 12". Bricks will be placed annually prior to the September 11 Dedication Ceremony. Orders must be received by August 1 to be placed the following month. When your brick is placed, you will be contacted to inform you of its location.

Plaques

12" x 12" bronze plaques are available for personalized engraving and placement on the designated wall within the Walk of Honor. The personalization can be up to 22 characters per line, up to 6 lines.

Benches

The Cambridge style benches are made from sturdy, weather-proof, HDPE recycled composite board. The engraving on the bench plaque can be up to 22 characters per line, up to 3 lines. Benches can be placed either in the Walk of Honor or in designated approved locations around main campus.
